May

- Accept your offer of admission in your myOkanagan account and pay your tuition deposit
- Check for additional items required for admission
- **Connect with an Indigenous Student Services Coordinator

June

- Attend a Plan Ahead session and build your course schedule
- Check your myOkanagan for your registration time
- **Meet with an Education Advisor or attend virtual drop-ins
- **Apply for student loans - Book appointment or attend virtual drop-ins
- **Register with Disability Access Services,

July

- Register for fall and winter courses
- Download the OC Safe App
- **Apply for OC Entrance Awards

August


- Order textbooks & course materials
- Check out the important dates for the semester
- Pay tuition fees by the deadline
- Complete OC 101 & OC Ready Moodle courses
- Submit Student ID request through myOkanagan account
- Read the Student Handbook
- Visit oscu.ca or vsao.ca (V) and check out free student services
- Opt out of health & dental benefits (K) or (V) by the deadline, if eligible
- **Purchase a parking pass online (K,P,V)

September

- Attend Orientation events
- REMINDER - Opt out of health & dental benefits (K) or (V) by the deadline, if eligible
- Visit the Student Union Office for your frosh (K)
- **Log into the Careers Hub portal through myOkanagan
- **Check out the Athletics, Recreation and Student Life guide (K) & the Penticton Facility monthly schedule (P)
- **Purchase a gym pass at your Campus Administration office or online (K,P,V)
- **Purchase bus pass from your students' union (K,P,V)

October

- Review Winter course registration
- **Start exploring housing options for next year
